#### Junior Staff Qualifications

1. Must have previously attended SLI.
2. Must be currently in grade 11 or 12 (2016-2017 school year) or a member of the IASC HS Div Executive Committee

#### Round Table Proposal

As a Junior Staff member, you will be expected to deliver a roundtable during camp. A roundtable is a 10-15 minute session on a topic or idea you will share with campers. No icebreakers will be allowed at roundtables.

1. Please describe the roundtable you can be comfortable leading. These can include, but are not limited to, Riley fundraisers, school spirit, community service, homecoming ideas, fundraisers, organizational skills, time management, etc.
2. Please include an outline of your roundtable – time frame, topics to be included.
3. Please provide any handouts you plan to give to campers in support of your roundtable.
4. Include any other information/props/descriptions you feel are necessary.

The roundtable component is an important part of the Junior Staff application and must be included with your application. Should you not include this roundtable proposal, you will not be considered for a Junior Staff position.

Some Junior Staff will be asked to lead short workshops covering student council offices – President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer and Representative. If you are willing to lead a workshop for one of these offices, please do items 1 – 4 listed above with this officer topic in mind.

#### Things to Remember

1. Camp dates are June 18 – 23, 2017. Staff arrives on Saturday, June 17.
2. Submission deadline – May 1, 2017
3. Your application must include all of the following
  - 2 letters of recommendation – one from your adviser; one from an adult of your choice
  - All of the completed pages contained in the application packet
  - The assessment completed by your adviser (p. 5 of the application packet)
  - A recent picture
  - The roundtable proposal mentioned above
4. All necessary signatures
5. All staff will be **volunteer**
