3. Application submission deadline - May 1, 2018
4. Your application must include all of the following
  - 2 letters of recommendation - one from college/university representative familiar with you and your work; one from an adult of your choice
  - All of the completed pages contained in the application packet
  - Background Disclosure Form (page 5)
  - A recent **DIGITAL** picture (head & shoulders shot) emailed to [rob.zeider@iasc.us](mailto:rob.zeider@iasc.us). This picture can simply be a selfie taken with your cell phone.
5. All necessary signatures
6. Signed release allowing the IASC to perform a background check
7. All staff are **volunteer** - *Camp housing & meals are provided by the IASC*
