Call for Discussion Group Leaders

Convention offers fantastic opportunities for student leadership learning—but only with your help.

The IASC is seeking local student council members to lead State Convention Discussion Groups. These Discussion Groups will be an integral part of our State Convention Program and will allow local student leaders the opportunity to be the "expert" on a local student council project as they share the details of these projects with Convention delegates.

We **NEED** all State Convention Schools to provide Discussion Group Leaders. **ALL** of you have great projects to share. These student leaders will work as a team of 2 in delivering a Discussion Group topic of their choice. Discussion group leaders will present 2–20 minute sessions during the Saturday afternoon workshop rotation. There will be approximately 20 delegates in each session. Discussion Group Leaders will need to provide handouts, etc in support of your chosen topic/project.

Additionally, the Discussion Group Leaders will facilitate a 20 minute Idea Exchange during the Workshop Rotation. There is no preparation needed for the Idea Exchange. The IASC will provide all materials necessary.

All Discussion Group Leaders will be recognized on stage during one of our General Sessions. Additionally, Discussion Group Leaders can use this service to meet one of the criteria of the *Indiana Distinguished Student Leader* Application.
