Executive Committee District Director

Description

The IASC Elementary Level Division Executive Committee shall consist of 6 elementary level student council advisers representing the 6 IASC Geographical Districts. These 6 advisers shall have the title of IASC EL Division District Director. The “West” Districts’ Directors shall be appointed by the EL Division Associate Director in odd number years. The “East” Districts’ Directors shall be appointed by the EL Division Associate Director in even number years. The term of service is 2 years; these being July 1 – June 30, the IASC fiscal year.

District Directors are essential for the delivery of IASC program. Below is a listing of expectations.

Expectations

1. To attend Elementary Level Division Executive Committee Meetings (typically 3 each year)
2. To work with the EL Division Associate Director in the planning and delivery of the EL Division Conferences (typically in the Fall)
3. To attend the IASC Advisers’ Conference (typically in September)
4. To attend the EL Division Honor Council Ceremony (typically in May)
5. To work collaboratively as a team to develop and deliver the EL Division Conferences’ leadership curriculum; the Advisers’ Conference program and the EL Division Honor Council Award program.
6. To deliver IASC communication to member schools.
7. To communicate with non-member schools in an effort to secure their membership
8. To mentor "rookie" advisers, checking in with them frequently, and assisting them when possible.
