Junior Staff Qualifications

1. Must have previously attended SLI. Completion of the Level 4 Camp Curriculum is important, however, not a requirement.
2. Must be currently in grade 11 or 12 (2019 - 2020 school year) or a member of the IASC HS Div. Executive Committee
3. Must be able & willing to deliver & facilitate leadership workshops to campers

2. As a Level 5 delegate, you will deliver camp curriculum to campers at the direction of Adult Camp Staff.
3. Camp dates are July 5 - 10, 2020.
4. Junior Staff arrive on Saturday, July 4 no later than 9 AM.
5. **Application submission deadline - *May 15, 2020***
6. Your application must include all of the following
 - 2 letters of recommendation - one from your adviser; one from an adult of your choice
 - All of the completed pages contained in the application packet
 - The assessment completed by your adviser (p. 5 of the application packet)
 - A recent **DIGITAL** picture (head & shoulders shot) emailed to michael.lovely@iasc.us
This picture can simply be a selfie taken with your cell phone.
7. All necessary signatures
8. All staff are **volunteer** - *Camp housing, meals & apparel are provided by the IASC*
