 - A recent **DIGITAL** picture (head & shoulders shot) emailed to michael.lovely@iasc.us.
This picture can simply be a selfie taken with your cell phone.

6. All staff are **volunteer** – *Camp housing, meals & apparel are provided by the IASC*
